The Electricians and AC Technicians have already been absorbed by the TDLR.

Your full time elected officers and industry leaders attended this meeting to state their opposition to this recommendation. We will need help in the future from all Plumbers Local Union 68 members by contacting their State Legislator during the upcoming Legislative session to voice their opposition to the recommendation. The next Legislative Session will begin in January of 2019. We will keep the membership informed of the next course of action to be taken by this fine organization. 
2018 RETIREES CHRISTMAS LUNCHEON


