Participants may fish from anywhere in the Galveston Bay area complex (including beachfront from High Island to the Freeport Jetties) and may be done from boat, pier, shore or by wading. Each person (including children) must hook and reel in their own fish. Adults may assist children in landing fish. Professional guides are not allowed to enter tournament, but may be hired by participants. All Texas Parks and Wildlife regulations apply. There will be no cancellation due to inclement weather. Each person shall participate at their own risk. All weather warnings and small craft advisories should be observed.

Entry fees are \$20 for Local 68 adult members and their immediate adult family members (spouse, son/daughter, parent, sibling), \$35 for adult NON members and no cost to Local 68 retirees and participants under age 18. Entry fees are due by Friday, April 19th. A \$10 late fee will be added to entries received after this date. No entries will be accepted after 4:30 pm Friday, April 26th. As you all are aware, times are slow right now with Plumber Local 68. If you are fortunate enough to be employed, keep up the good

work. However, if you are looking to travel to another local union to find employment, please give me a call at the office (713) 869-3592.

IMPORTANT INCOME TAX CHANGES

The tax rules have changed recently. We would like to inform you that you can no longer deduct union dues and working assessments when filing your taxes. As per the new *Tax Cuts and Job Act* (affecting tax years 2018-2025) anything paid starting January 1,

2018 is no longer deductible for income tax. It has been eliminated as an unreimbursed business expense deduction on your income tax. As always, we urge you to contact your tax professional for more detailed help.

SUNSET ADVISORY COMMISSION

The Sunset Advisory Committee is moving forward with their recommendation to merge the Texas State Board of Plumbing Examiners into the Texas Department of Licensing and Regulation. The recommendation is being processed into a bill that should be out soon. Your full-time officers and organizers, along with other industry stakeholders including Texas PAMCA and PHCC, are working to prevent the bill from becoming law. We

will continue to work with our legislative friends including Representatives Senfronia Thompson, Poncho Nevarez, Kirk Watson and Stan Lambert and will let you know what you can do to help via letter, Facebook and/or email. This is an industry issue which will affect ALL licensed plumbers in the state, union and open shop. Updates will be given in future newsletters, apprentice classes and at our union meetings.
